- Perform analysis, design, programming and implementation of systems and procedures to address complex business needs
- Integrate campus enterprise systems with vendor and internally-developed systems
- Review business procedures and make recommendations for improvement through automation

- Modify University Housing systems to accommodate changing business requirements, user needs, and technological changes.
